

Statement of Faith

We believe the **Bible** is the holy, inspired Word of God and is without errors. The Bible is fully trustworthy, the one and only supreme and final authority in all issues of life and faith. (2 Peter 1:20-21, 2 Timothy 3:16-17)

We believe in one **God**, eternally existing in three Persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. (Deuteronomy 6:4, Galatians 1:1, Ephesians 4:6, Romans 9:5, Colossians 2:9, John 1:1, Acts 5:3-4)

We believe in the deity of our Lord **Jesus Christ**, His virgin birth, sinless life, His miracles and atoning death through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, and in His ascension to the right hand of the Father. (Isaiah 7:14, Matthew 1:23, 1 Timothy 3:16, Johns 1:14, Philippians 2:6)

We believe that **man** was created in the image of God, but because of sin, was alienated from God. As a result, all men everywhere are lost and face the judgment of God, and need to come to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ through His shed blood on the cross. Only through faith, trusting in Jesus Christ alone for salvation, are we reconciled to God. This **reconciliation** was made possible through the death of Christ on our behalf and His resurrection from the dead. (Acts 16:31, 1 Corinthians 15:3-4, Romans 10:9, John 14:6, Ephesians 2:8-9)

We believe in **eternal life** in heaven for the saved believer, and the eternal punishment in hell for the lost. (John 6:47, John 10:10, Revelation 22:5)

We believe Jesus Christ will **come again** to the earth in power and glory - both personally and visibly - to complete history and the eternal plan of God. (1 Thessalonians 4:13-5:4, Matthew 24:29-31)

We believe in **holy Christian living**, through the power of the Holy Spirit. (2 Peter 1:3)

We believe that all Christians are instructed and encouraged to be **actively involved** in a local **church body**. It is in the church that growth will be nourished and encouraged. It is also the vessel God uses for His will to be accomplished through believers to minister to the world. (Hebrews 13:7, Ephesians 4:11-16, Hebrews 10:25, Romans 12:5, 1 Corinthians 12:14-23)
