The Todd Becker Foundation, an evangelism youth ministry that puts on outreach events throughout the Midwest, is seeking a reliable and honorable individual to fill a position of: **Tour Bus Driver**

Job Description: This person is primarily responsible for the safe, efficient and courteous operation of the ministry tour bus that transports team members to each event. In addition to the bus driving responsibilities, this person assists in the set-up and tear-down of all sound, staging, lighting and video equipment that is associated with each event. Also, in times while not traveling for outreach events, this person assumes the responsibility of the "DOT SAFETY & COMPLIANCE OFFICER" for the Todd Becker Foundation and ensures that all such DOT regulations are met, both in regards to the operation of vehicles as well as the necessary paperwork, vehicles postings and filings associated with such DOT regulations.

Requirements: A Class B CDL is required, and a Passenger Bus Endorsement is a major plus. If applicant does not currently have a Passenger Bus Endorsement, classes and training can be done to help applicant obtain the necessary endorsement(s). In addition, experience with DOT regulations, filings and compliance issues is a major plus. This individual must be a healthy, hard worker with a positive attitude towards life and his or her work. Ultimately, this individual must have a strong desire and passion to serve Christ and His kingdom, as well as have a teachable spirit willing to grow not only in this ministry position, but also in their relationship with the Lord. Also, this individual must enjoy traveling, as this position requires weekly travel across the Midwest.

Wages & Benefits: The position is a 9-month salaried position (school year), with summers typically off or with limited responsibilities. Salary is \$34,000 to \$41,000 per school year (9-month term), depending on experience. Benefits include accumulating paid time off.

How to apply: We ask applicants to first pray and seek God's will for their lives and if He would have them serve with the Todd Becker Foundation. After prayer, applicants that feel God leading them to join the ministry of the Todd Becker Foundation should submit a brief letter and resume via email to: info@toddbecker.org.
